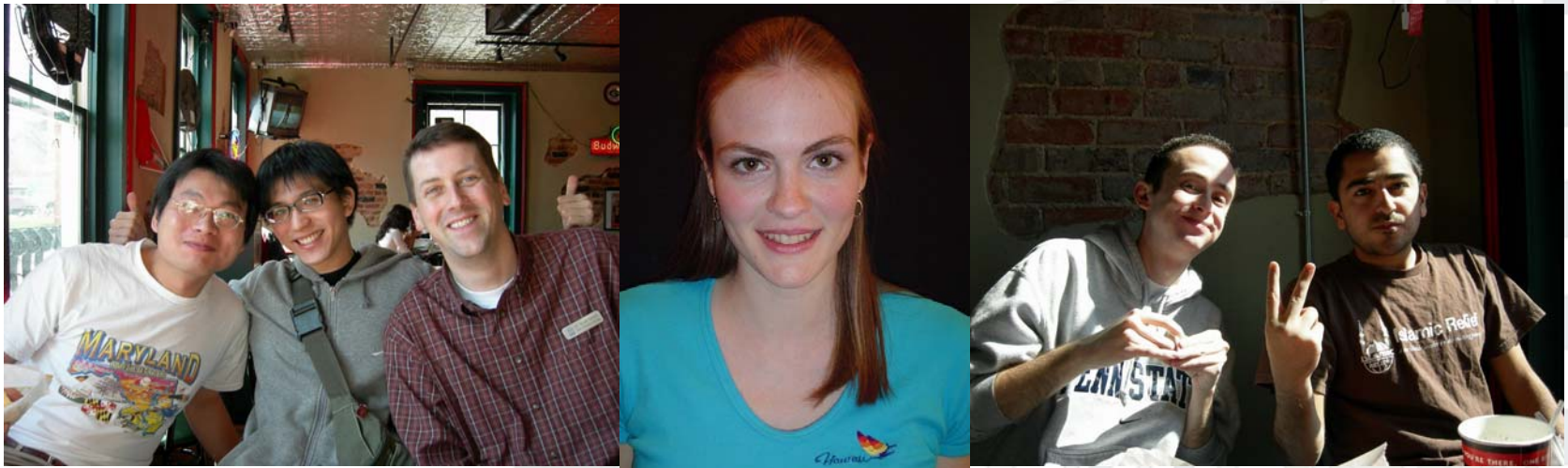

# My Role

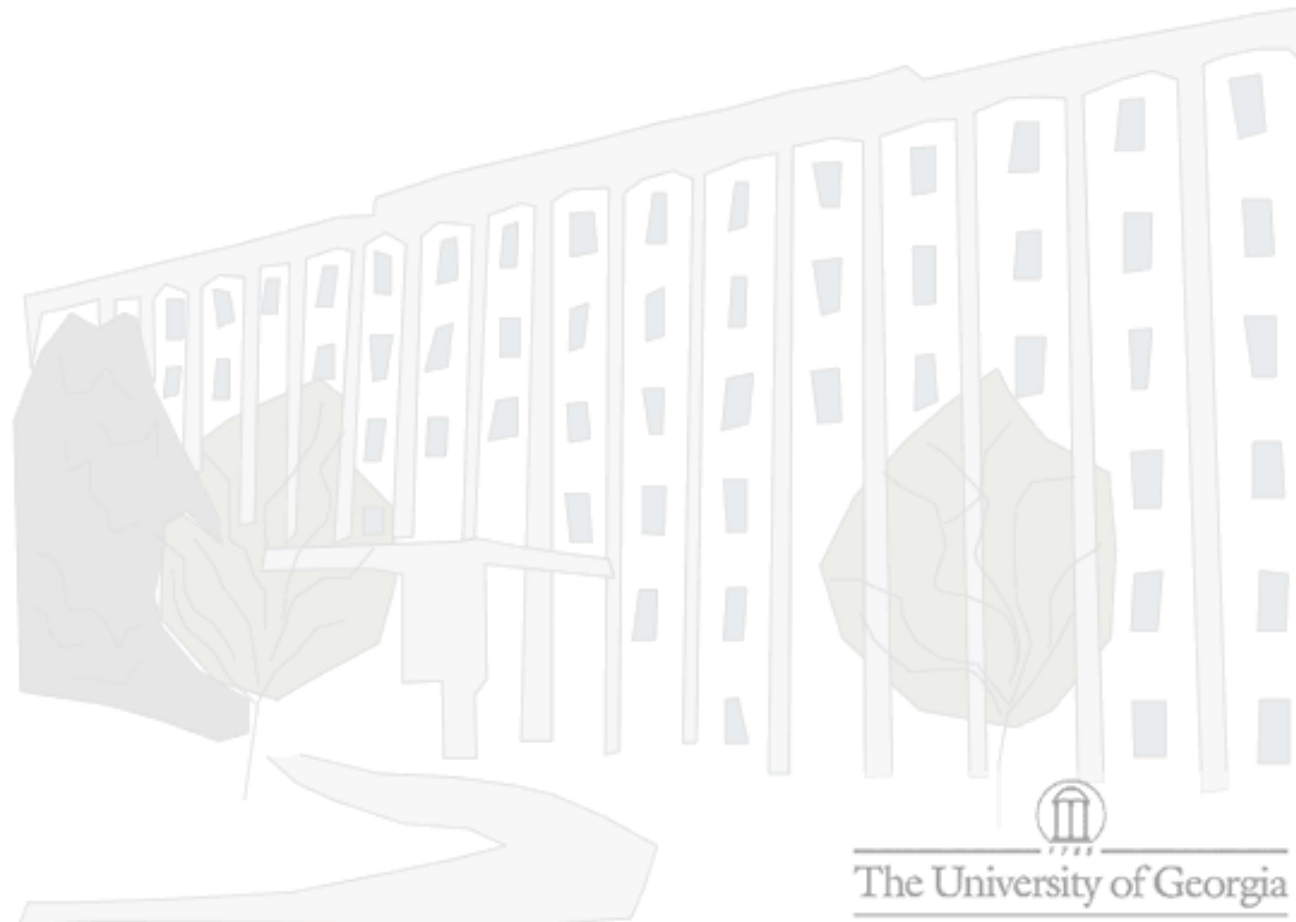
I am the creative manager of the Teaching With Technology Portal. My responsibilities include the maintenance and development of our educational technology resources and support portal.
